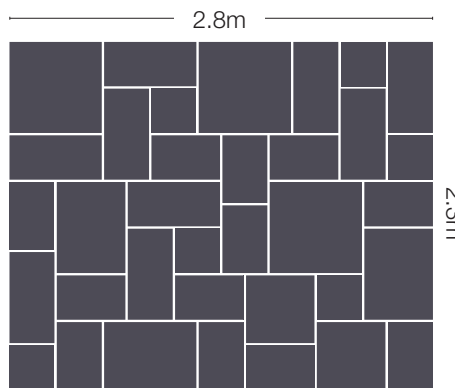


# BRADSTONE

## OLD TOWN® PATIO FEATURE KIT LAYING INSTRUCTIONS

### 6.4m<sup>2</sup> patio pack

#### Approx size:

2800 x 2300mm

#### Kit consists of:

- 600 x 600mm = 3
- 600 x 450mm = 3
- 450 x 450mm = 2
- 600 x 300mm = 9
- 450 x 300mm = 12
- 300 x 300mm = 6

1. Strip topsoil, dig to subsoil/firm ground.
2. Set 4 corner pegs to form a rectangle for the patio. Check accuracy by measuring corner to corner. Both measurements should be the same.
3. 'Dry lay' all the paving from one corner to check accuracy and establish joint widths\*. Using pegs and string lines, mark out the area to be paved.
4. Lay level concrete foundations using 1 part cement to 6 part sandy ballast, minimum depth 150mm.
5. Carefully lay the first paving stone in one corner on a bed of mortar (1 part cement to 3 or 4 parts soft sand). Tap down the centre of the stone with

a wooden or rubber mallet to the required height. Repeat, ensuring that the paving is level using a spirit level and the joints are evenly placed.

6. On completion, fully point all joints using a mortar mix of 3 points building sand to 1 part cement. The mix should not be too wet or too dry. If building on an existing concrete base, start construction at stage 3, but omit stage 4. If not building on an existing concrete base, you will need cement and sandy ballast for foundations.

\*Joint widths - when laying random paving, joint widths will depend on the paving type and laying pattern and will only be variable - from 10mm to 30mm. The dimensions given for the Patio Feature Kit laying patterns are therefore only approximate and dry laying first is always recommended.

All measurements and sizes are approximate.
